

WHO ARE THEY?

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"After finishing his studies, **Aziz Sahmaoui** moved to Paris and co-founded one of the seminal bands of the 1990s, **L'Orchestre National de Barbès (ONB)** - a machine designed to scare the living daylights out of identity obsessives and frontier-guardsmen.

After releasing two albums with **ONB**, he joined one of the pioneers of cosmopolitan cultural cross-breeding, the pianist **Joe Zawinul**, old sparring partner of **Miles Davis** and founder of **Weather Report**, who liked nothing better than signing up African virtuosi to his blue-sky ensemble. It was in **Zawinul's Syndicate** that **Aziz Sahmaoui** met various musicians with whom went on to form the band **University of Gnawa**, a band that, since 2010, has never stopped deconstructing that chimera created by the label 'world music': a hand-book of 'folkified' identities put together for the benefit of the northern hemisphere.

With its Senegalese, its Frenchmen, its North Africans and its musicians of no fixed origin, University of Gnawa dishes up a style of music whose catalyst is trance. At the heart of their adventure there's a reconciliation, between the rhythmic genius of Africa above and Africa below the Sahara, whose ineluctable bond University of Gnawa embodies with instinctive mastery and skill."
